How to navigate the fees and charges form

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1 Definition of a Resident

A person is deemed to be an inhabitant (resident) if at the date of death:

- a. They resided within Harlington Civil Parish
- b. They died while in hospital, nursing home, old peoples home or institution of any kind - and their last residence had been within Harlington Parish
- c. They had moved from Harlington within the preceding 12 months having been resident throughout the previous 5 years.
- d. Persons not within one or more of the criteria above are classed as non residents

2 IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- a Grave and Cremation Plot reservation fees apply when a grave or plot space is 'next in line'. (Harlington Garden Cemetery)
- b Materials of all lawn memorials must be of natural quarried stone and erected using an approved, recognised system of fixing i.e. National Association of Memorial Masons. In all cases a drawing of the memorial, showing details of dimensions, inscription and the design must be submitted to the Parish Council for approval.
- c Temporary Lawn memorials are not allowed other than a wood marker of a suitable size. Temporary wooden markers are only permitted until such time as a permanent memorial is erected or for a period of 18 months, whichever is the sooner.
- d Natural (green) memorials are restricted to an engraved wooden marker of a suitable size. In all cases a drawing of the memorial, showing details of dimensions, inscription and the design must be submitted to the Parish Council for approval.
- e No kerbs of any kind is permitted in the Harlington Garden Cemetery
- f No adornment, decoration or additional items are permitted. Any such item will be removed by the Council.
If there is any doubt, please contact the Parish Clerk for assistance.
- g Stone chippings, bark mulch and other decorative coverings are not permitted on any the grave or cremation plots.
- h Floral tributes from the funeral may be removed by the council when withered
- i Specific regulations relating to the Children's and NATURAL (green) burial areas can be found in the handbook
- j All fees shown include the digging fee, the Interment fee and the EROB (unless specified)

3 Reserving a plot

Reservations are limited to one plot adjacent to a family member at the time of initial interment or at the discretion of the Burial Authority

a LAWN GRAVE AND NATURAL (green) GRAVE

Reservation of a grave for 10 years.

Renewals of reservation 50% of current rate.

EROB and interment fees need to be paid at time of use

b (Double depth) Garden of rest 18" x 18" - Simultaneous double or single interment of ashes in a cremation plot

6 Harlington Garden Cemetery - Child Grave

Infant and Child Fees: Interment in a single depth grave not exceeding 12 years of age

a Body of still-born infant or child where grave space does not exceed 3ft x 2ft

b Child grave exceeding 3'x2'

8 Memorials

For the right to erect and maintain on a specified location

- a Memorial & base (without kerbs) for LAWN grave not exceeding 36" (H) x 30" (W) x 12" (D). Including the 1st inscription. New or replacement
 b Memorial for Cremation plots not exceeding 18"x18"x4" Including the 1st inscription. New or replacement (for larger height please contact the Burial Authority)
 c Additional inscription after the 1st inscription for each name

9 Dedication (Memorial) Trees and Benches

Trees and Benches remain the property of Harlington Parish Council

Dedications are only permitted for persons interred in the cemetery (as at 2021)

- a Dedication of a tree for 15 years (not on a grave) HPC to supply and plant tree in agreed location (including plaque)
 b Dedication of a tree for 15 years (not on a grave) for an existing established tree (including plaque)
 c Dedication of teak bench for 10 years (Bench provided and include installation plaque and maintenance)
 d Renewal of dedication tree or bench for 5 years

11 Harlington Cemetery Lincoln Way (the old cemetery)

- a **Burial Plots** Re-opening and burial in an existing grave (depth permitting)

 Garden of rest 18" x 18" - interment of ashes in a cremation plot (depth permitting)
Memorials - For the right to erect and maintain on a specified location
 c Headstone, new or replacement (without kerbs) not exceeding 36" (height) x 24" (width) x 12" (depth). Including the 1st inscription.
 d An ashes memorial not exceeding 18"x18"x4" Including the 1st inscription. New or replacement
 e Replacement memorial (with kerbs) inc 1st inscription (ONLY to replace existing kerb set memorial)
 f Additional inscription after the 1st inscription for each name
